Once again I will be welcoming students and others, this time at my new home on the Village Green at the St. Lawrence Power & Equipment Mu-

seum in Madrid, NY. I have been called "historically and architecturally significant as a highly intact, surviving example of a mid-19th century vernacular one-room rural schoolhouse." Graffiti leave hints of students long ago. The estimated cost of my relocation and renovation is \$25,000. With your help, my new life can begin this year.
